

Enrolling Your Child at East Lansing Public Schools

If you are a resident of the School District of the City of East Lansing you may enroll your children in the East Lansing School District (please refer to the boundary map on our website). Children must be living with a parent or legal guardian.

Our district has four elementary schools that serve kindergarten through 4th grade students. They are Donley Elementary, Marble Elementary, Pinecrest Elementary and Red Cedar Elementary. Two schools serve 5th and 6th grade students in our district. They are Glencairn Elementary and Whitehills Elementary. 7th and 8th grade students attend MacDonald Middle School. Students in grades 9 through 12 attend East Lansing High School.

To enroll your child in school you may go directly to your school to obtain enrollment paperwork. For students in kindergarten through 6th grade, please see the boundary map to determine your neighborhood school. Please bring with you the following items:

Proof of Residency (two forms are required) - a drivers license or voter registration card (counts as one), lease agreement, moving bill, purchase agreement, utility bill, insurance bill or some other official mail addressed to your address in our district

Proof of Birth - the child's original certified birth certificate (the one issued by the county) must be presented to the registrar at the school

Proof of Immunizations

High School students should also bring a copy of their transcript when enrolling.
